A. Personal Statement

I was trained as a veterinarian and early on specialized in communicable disease epidemiology with special interest in enteric diseases and zoonoses. Having lobbied for the establishment of a population-based cancer registry for Guam, I became the first director of the Guam Cancer Registry as a collateral duty to my position as Territorial Epidemiologist. The Guam Cancer Registry remained an unfunded mandate of the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPH&SS) until funding was provided under the U56 grant. I retired from Government of Guam civil service in 2004 but continue working part-time as a consultant for DPH&SS. I am currently especially interested in studying the long-term effects resulting from TCDD and TCE contamination of Guam's northern water lens by the military.
